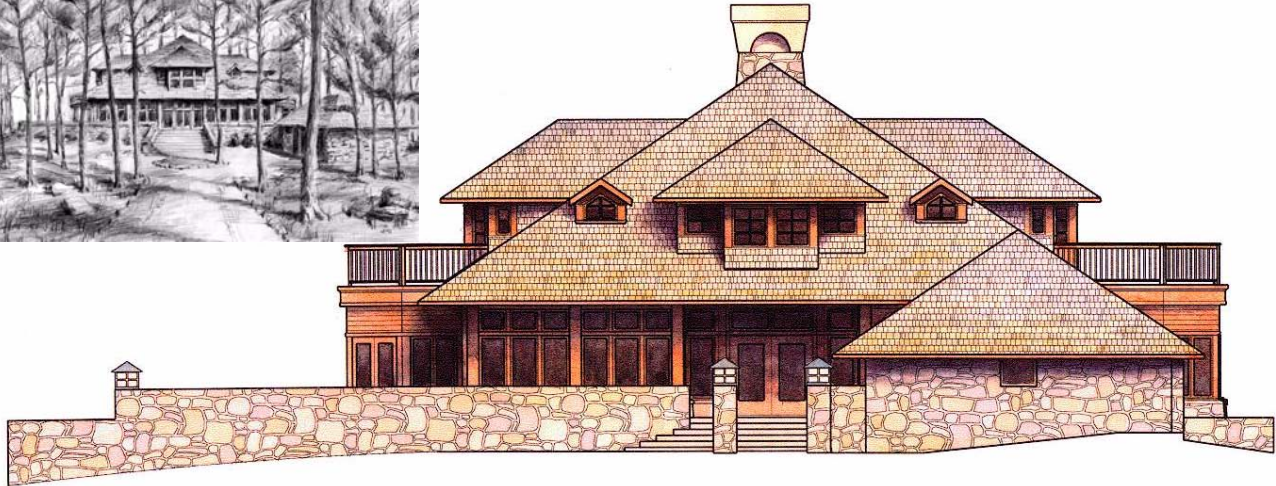


# Starland

An interesting new recreational residential project is emerging on the shore of a Muskoka lake for June completion. This particular site has given Jim Ireland, Vice President of residential and recreational design, both a few challenges and some outstanding opportunities.

Wonderful views over water, filtered through pines and hemlocks, contrast to a very beautiful wooded Muskoka hillside enclosing the new building, and affording special privacy. Placement of the building has been carefully considered, working closely with our clients and builder, to avoid difficult soil conditions while exploiting these outlooks. Garages and boathouse form edges of a courtyard area at the

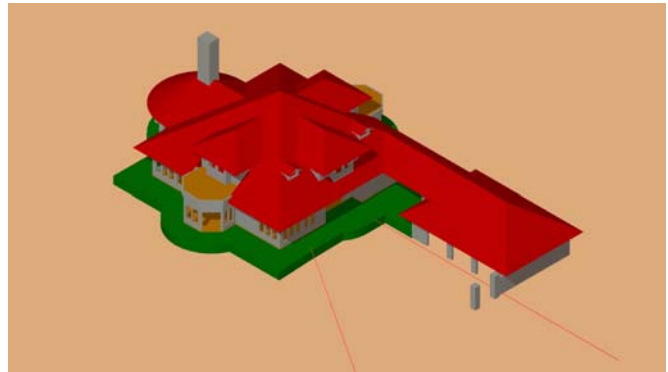
point of arrival from road or water which leads to the entry of the home.

Materials have been selected to relate visually to the natural beauty of the property. Much will remain

unseen from the waters edge as a result of protection of the mature trees edging the shore. Rust coloured stain combines with the sand-gray indigenous stone of the foundation and chimney.
