A new timber frame structure is rising at Skyloft Ski & Country Club to be ready for the coming ski season. Ireland Architects Inc. has designed the facility to replace the original 54 year old lodge. Raising of the timber frame for the new clubhouse was completed on schedule September 1. The timbers form an integral part of the interior finishing in keeping with the old lodge. A massive double stone fireplace will serve both the main cafeteria space and a new lounge. Large window areas ensure that views over the valley and the ski runs will be available from all major spaces.
